REQUIREMENTS FOR:

PROJECT, THESIS, STUDY SYLLABUS AND DISSERTATION WRITING

If there is an average of 250 words on a typesetting page that is double spaced, then a requirement of:

- 10,000 words would result in a paper of at least 40 pages
- 20,000 words would result in a paper of at least 80 pages
- 25,000 words would result in a paper of at least 100 pages
- 30,000 words would result in a paper of at least 120 pages.

C O N D I T I O N S

Candidates for the Bachelor's Degree will have to write a Project/Thesis, or study syllabus of 10,000 words on an A4 size paper.

Candidates for the Master's Degree will have to write a thesis or study syllabus of 20,000 words in A4 size paper.

Candidates for the Doctorate Degree will have to write a Dissertation or study syllabus of 25,000 words in A4 size paper.

Candidates for Post Doctorate (Research Only) will have to write a Dissertation or study syllabus of 30,000 words in A4 paper.

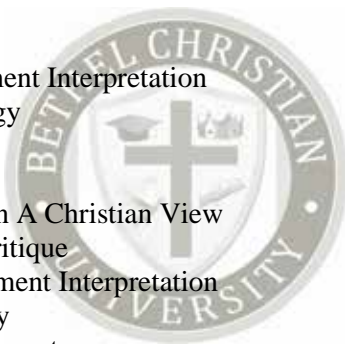
